## Incubation Project review criteria

To be accepted into the Early Adoption stage, a project must meet all the requirements of the Incubation stage (OK) plus:

- Demonstrate growth in the project's community, including
  - Growth in the number of commits to the project, number of project committers, and organizational diversity of contributions and committers => In progress
  - Production or planned production use of the project by at least two independent end users which, in the TAC's judgement, are of
    adequate quality and scope No release done yet. Furthermore, the project is subdivided in two part: the SCT parts, and the CIM
    conversion part. We are working on commons, and we have to try to define what could be a release. Expected at the end of the
    year.
- Technical Governance of the project is operational, as measured by:
  - A Technical Steering Committee with at least 5 members and a chairperson elected by the members, holding regular open meetings => 6
    members, a chairperson, monthly meetings (see next slide)
  - Achievement of the Core Infrastructure Initiative Best Practice badge at the 'Passing' Level => Not yet done
- Development of a growth plan, to be done in conjunction with their project mentor(s) at the TAC. This plan should address the following points => To do
  - Release plans for the next 18 months.
  - Target end-users.
  - o Identification of any regulatory or standards body requirements for deployment, and plans for implementation.
  - Plans for growth of project contributors and committers to support the growth plan.
    - Since these metrics can vary significantly depending on the type, scope and size of a project, the TAC has final judgement over the level of activity that is adequate to meet these criteria.
- Identification of any infrastructure resources needed to fulfill the growth plan => To do
- Presentation to the TAC of the project's growth, technical governance, and growth plan => To do
- Receive the affirmative majority vote of the TAC and Governing Board

COMPAS was created to provide the software bricks necessary for the deployment of digital substations.

The purpose of the CoMPAS project is to develop open source software components related to IEC 61850 standard mainly for the configuration of power industry Protection Automation and Control System (PACS).


