### **Opening and General Updates**

#### **GridFM Presentation**

François Miralles presented the GridFM project. They explained the purpose and mission of the project along with challenges future power grids face and how they hope to alleviate some of them. They shared their roadmap and communities they are collaborating with. A discussion ensued with the TAC regarding the work with PowSyBI. There were suggestions to look into Power Grid Model and Dynawo. There was a question regarding the annual review and what SIG it would fall under. Alexandre Parisot mentioned that the AI SIG isn't built to handle reviews and suggested the review for GridFM take place at a TAC meeting.
